Our major project and the most exciting program for *Grupo de Veinte* since 2015 was to help eliminate a devastating cause of children's severe burns from kerosene lamps and candles used in their homes plus where 95% of the women suffer respiratory ailments developed from a long history of breathing the fumes from kerosene lamps and candles. *Grupo de Veinte* purchased and installed 198 Solar Lighting Systems, which brought light to 996 people that live in some

Radio Licenses (\$550) & Transformers purchased for Velille & Colquemarca (\$1,020). All Christian broadcasting will now emanate from Sicuani daily.
